PRESS RELEASE

Hyderabad, 07-07-2014: The Rajiv Gandhi University of Knowledge Technologies (RGUKT) has scheduled to release the provisional list of shortlisted candidates for 2807 seats and a proportionate wait list (20%) on seats other than special category for the admission into six year integrated B.Tech Programme 2014-20. Shri Ganta Srinivas Rao, Hon'ble minister of HRD, Andhra Pradesh state and Shri G. Jagadeshwar Reddy, Hon'ble Minister for Education, Telangana state have released the CDs containing the shortlisted candidates at 11:30AM on 07.07.2014 in the Auditorium Hall, Jawaharlal Nehru Architecture and Fine Arts University at Masab Tank, Hyderabad.

The selections for counseling for the academic year 2014 have been made in accordance with the Presidential Order, in concurrence with the Statute-13 (3) of RGUKT Act and the direction of the Government in its letter No. 2934/EC/A1/2014-01, dated 17.05.2014 which facilitates the addition of deprivation score of 0.4 to the tenth class GPA of the applicants from non-residential government schools including Zilla Parishad and Municipal Schools.

The counseling for the shortlisted candidates in the open and reserved category (excluding special categories) will be conducted at RGUKT Campuses at Basar in (Adilabad dist, Telangana state) Nuzvid (Krishna dist, AP) and Idupulapaya (YSR Kadapa dist, AP) on 23th and 24th July'2014. It is mandatory for the shortlisted candidates to attend the counseling on the prescribed date along with necessary original certificates. Candidates who do not attend the counseling will forfeit their claim for admission. The counseling will be held for the waitlisted candidates on 27th July'2014 for allotment of seats in case of any leftover seats in the first counseling. The counseling for the special categories like sports and games, NCC, CAP and PH will be conducted on 17.7.2014 and 18.07.2014 at the RGUKT Head quarters in Hyderabad. The list will be uploaded on the university website after releasing of the admission results. The shortlisted and waitlisted candidates will be intimated via SMS as well as by post.

Statistical data of shortlisted candidates

1. The ratio of Girls and Boys among those selected is 45.849 : 54.150 respectively.
2. The overall percent of students selected from the non residential government schools (including Zilla Parishad and Municipal Schools) is 85.46%.
3. The percent of students selected from private and government residential schools is 14.54%.
4. The percent of students selected from rural areas is 85.215% while that from urban is 14.89%
5. The following table shows the percent of students selected from government schools and private schools separately for Andhra University, Osmania University and Sri Venkateswara University local areas.
